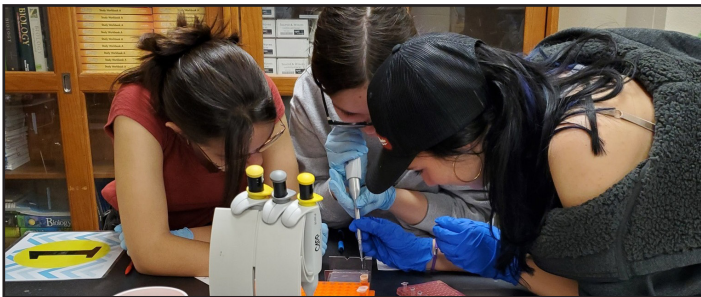


A NEW YEAR, A NEW SEMESTER
